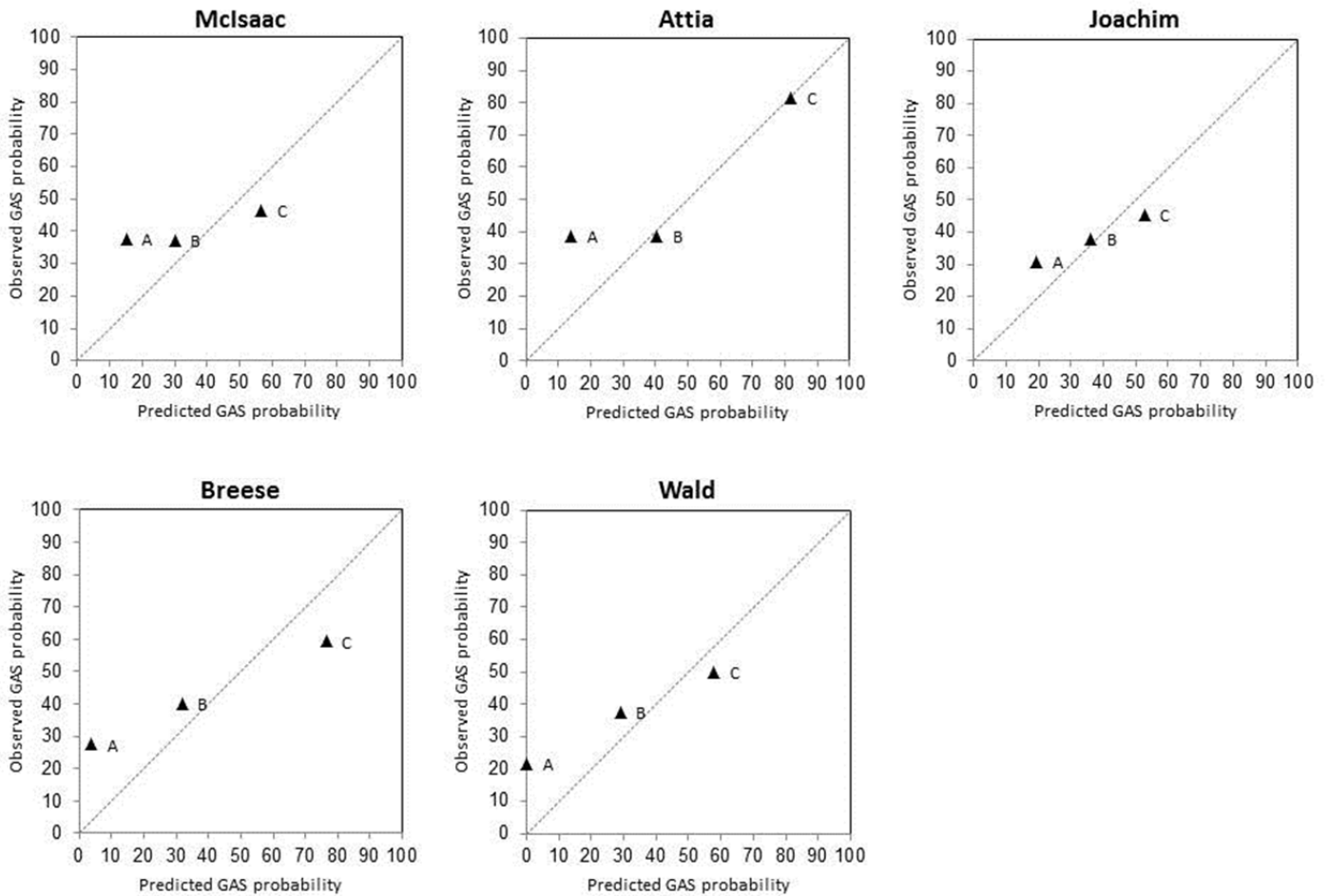


Appendix 10: Calibration plots of the external validation of clinical prediction rules

Each point corresponds to a risk level defined by the clinical prediction rule. Breese: A, score ≤ 25 ; B, score 26–31; C, score ≥ 32 . Mclsaac: A, score ≤ 1 ; B, score 2–3; C, score ≥ 4 . Wald: A, score ≥ 1 ; B, score 2–4; C, score ≥ 5 . Attia: A, score 0; B, score 1–3; C, score ≥ 4 . Joachim: A, score ≤ 2 ; B, score 3; C, score ≥ 4 . Predicted group A streptococcus (GAS) probabilities adjusted for prevalence. The diagonal line corresponds to perfect calibration.
