Appendix 4 (as supplied by the authors): Description of the sensitivity analyses

- 1. Used a stricter identification algorithm requiring one hospitalization, two physician claims within three years or two or more prescriptions for ADHD drugs in a year plus one physician claim within three years.
- 2. Required a minimum age of 6 years to identify ADHD diagnosis.
- 3. Included in-hospital antibiotic dispensation in exposure definition which was not included in the main analysis due to the limited data years and geographic coverage of the in-hospital dispensation dataset.
- 4. Included prenatal smoking, alcohol and drug use in the model in a subset of the cohort who had data available on these variables.
- 5. Restricted the cohort to firstborn children.
- 6. Censored the children at the ages of 6 and 12 years instead of 18 years.

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
