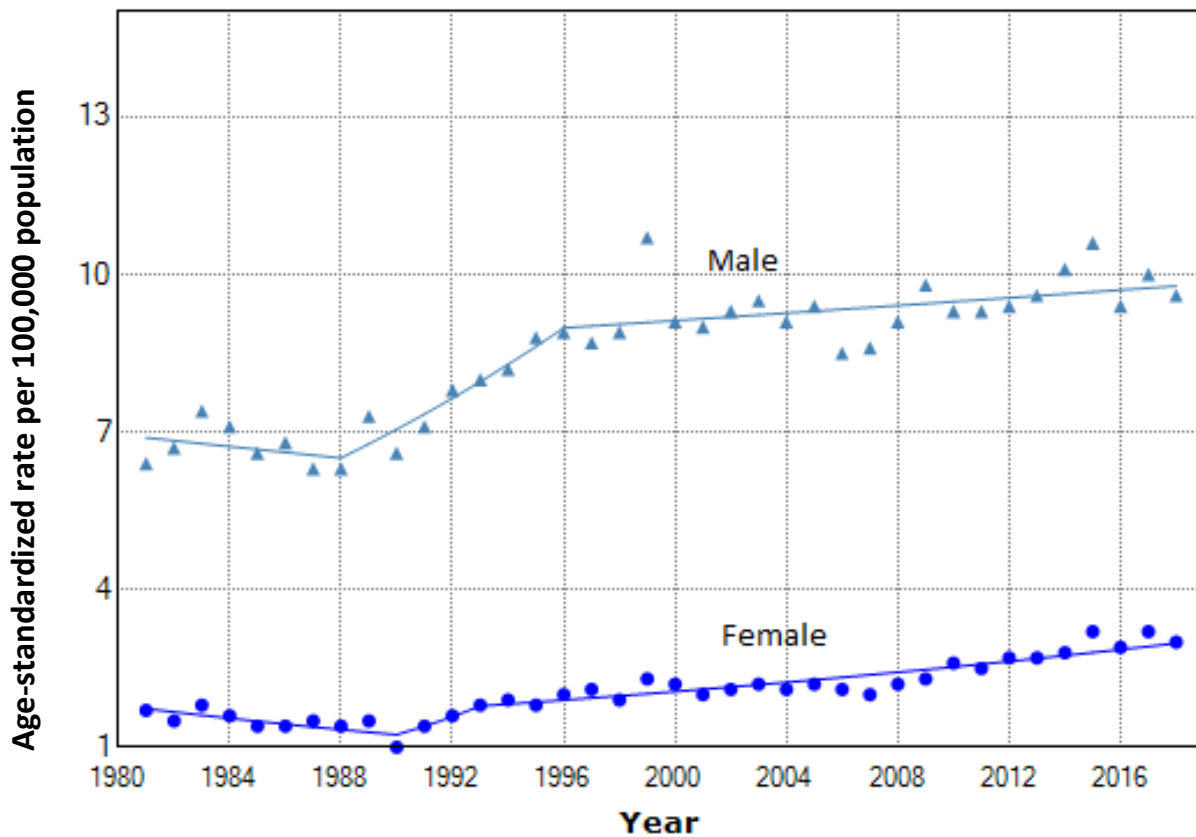


Figure S1. Age-standardized mortality rates of suicide by suffocation, hanging or strangulation by sex in Canada, 1981-2018.

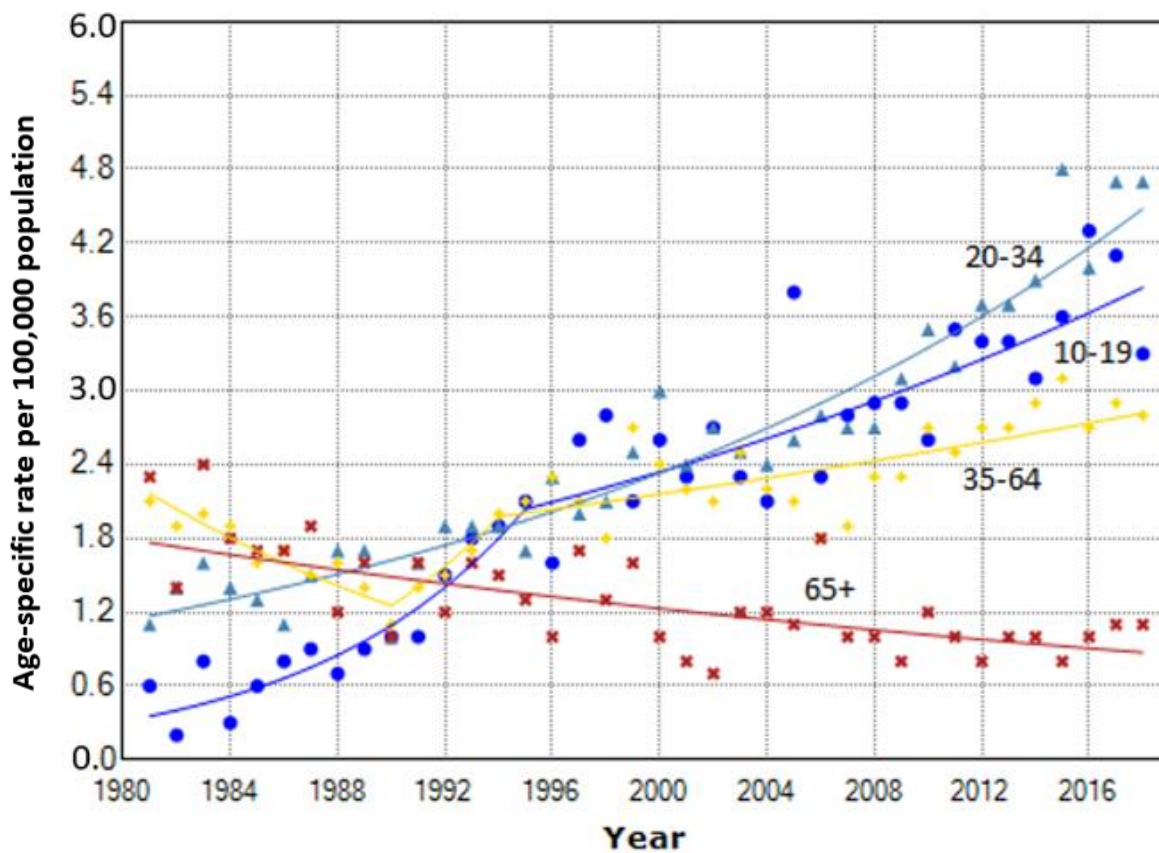


Figure S2. Age-specific mortality rates of suicide by suffocation, hanging or strangulation for females by age group in Canada, 1981-2018.

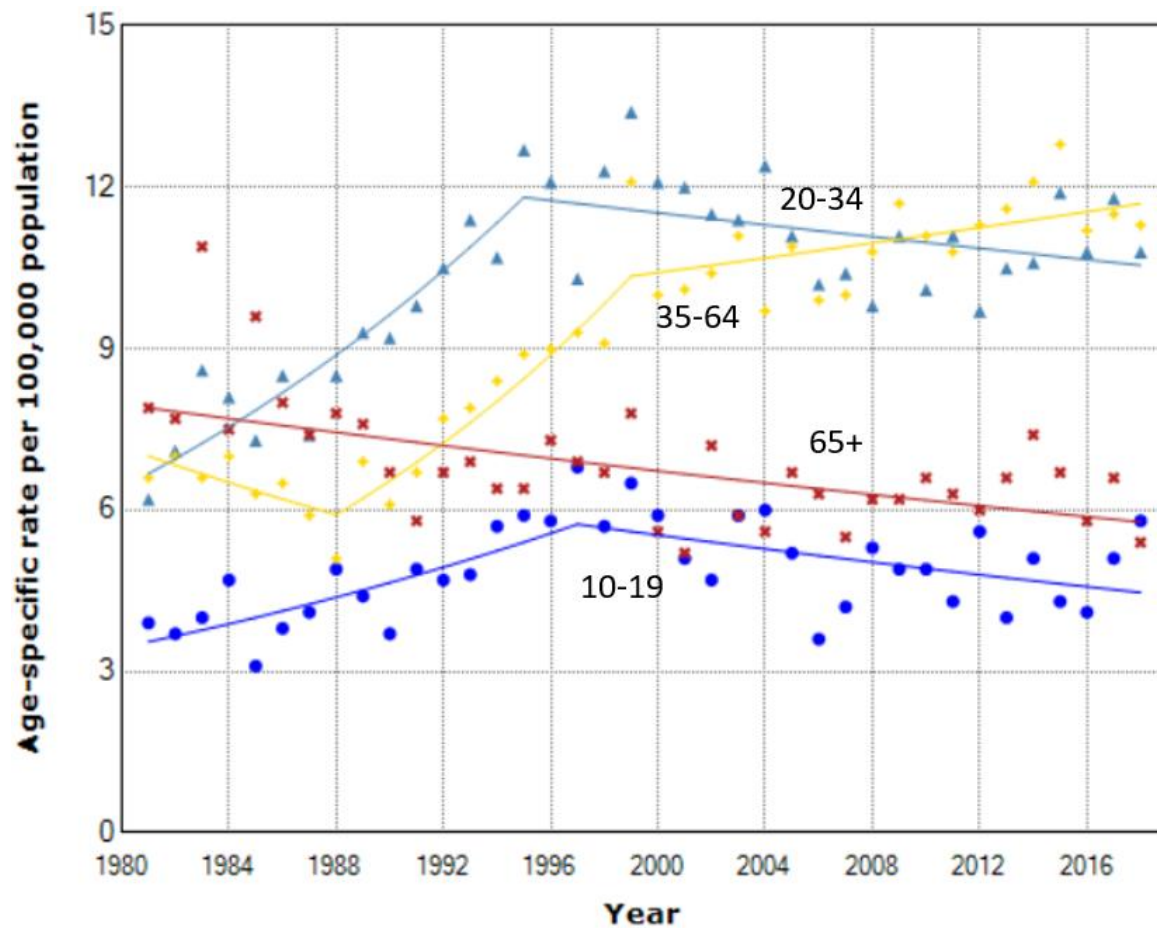


Figure S3. Age-specific mortality rates of suicide by suffocation, hanging or strangulation for males by age group in Canada, 1981-2018.

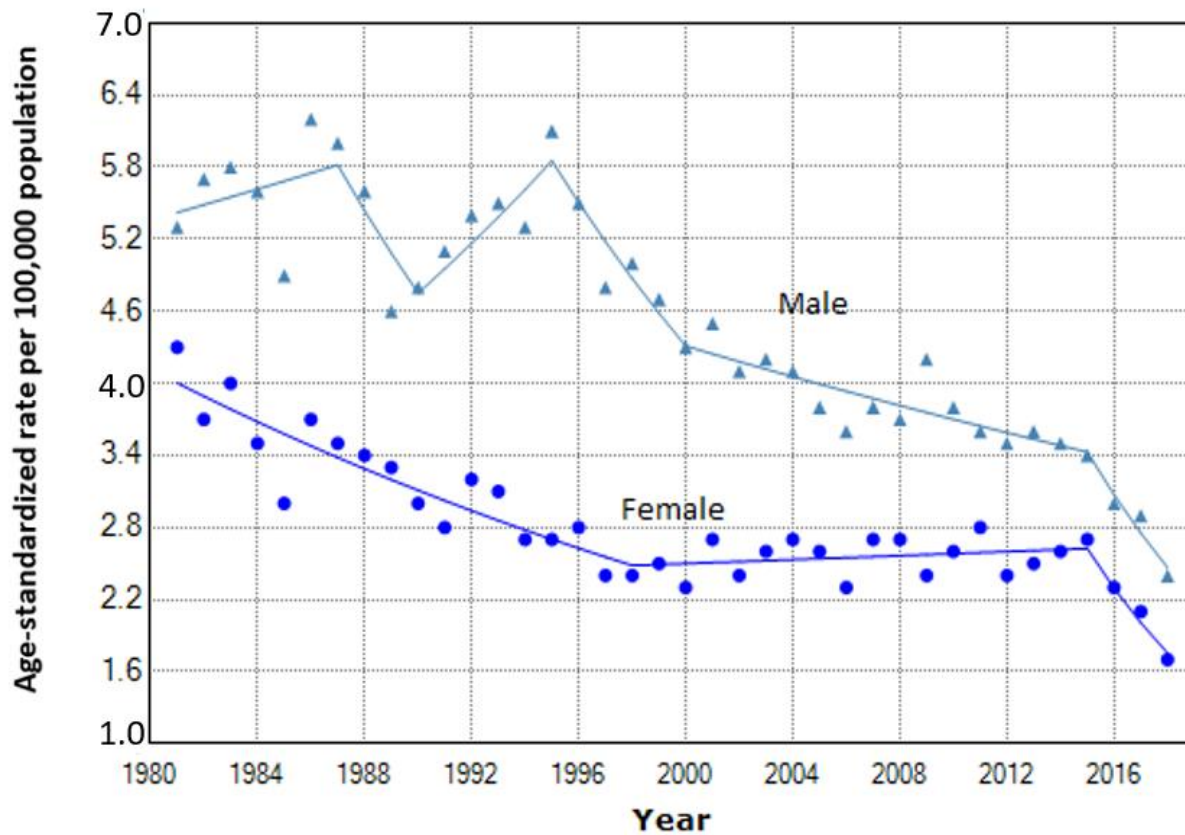


Figure S4. Age-standardized mortality rates of suicide by poisoning by sex in Canada, 1981-2018.

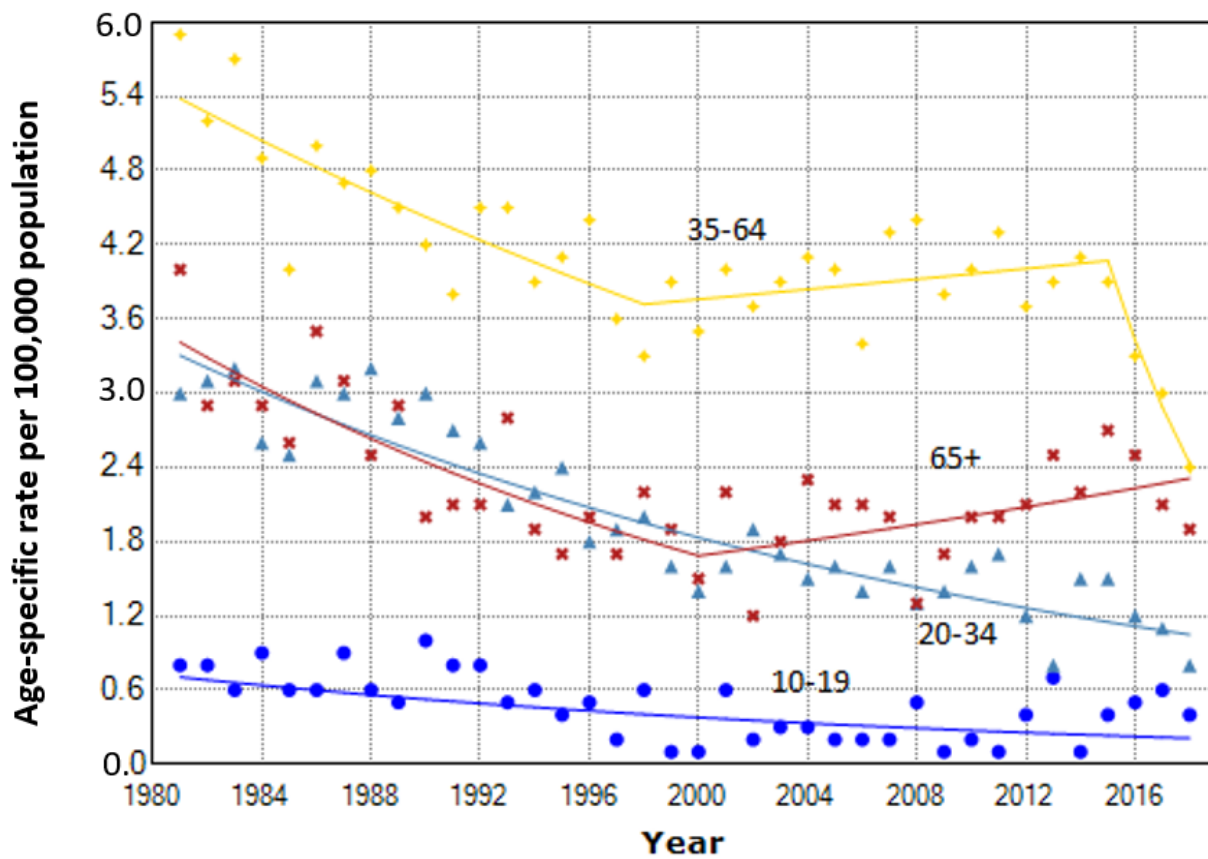


Figure S5. Age-specific mortality rates of suicide by poisoning for females by age group in Canada, 1981-2018.

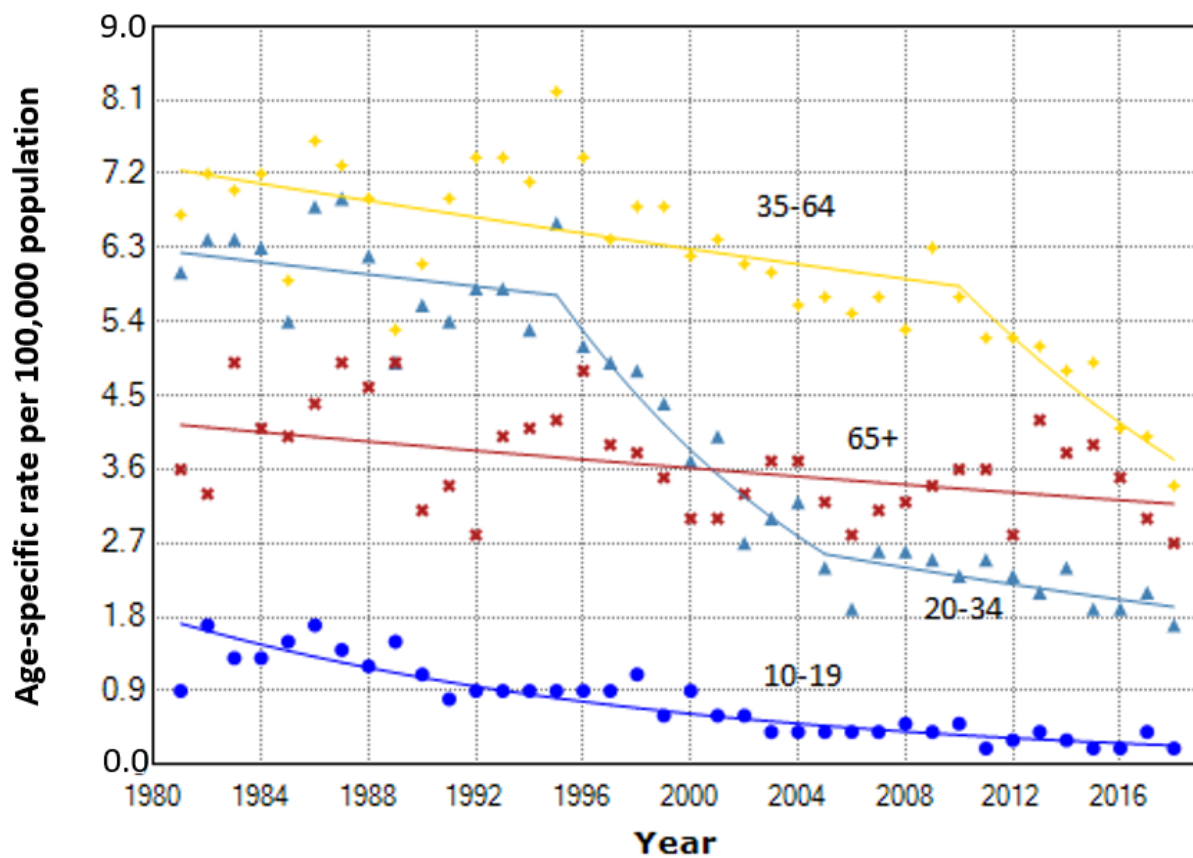


Figure S6. Age-specific mortality rates of suicide by poisoning for males by age group in Canada, 1981-2018.

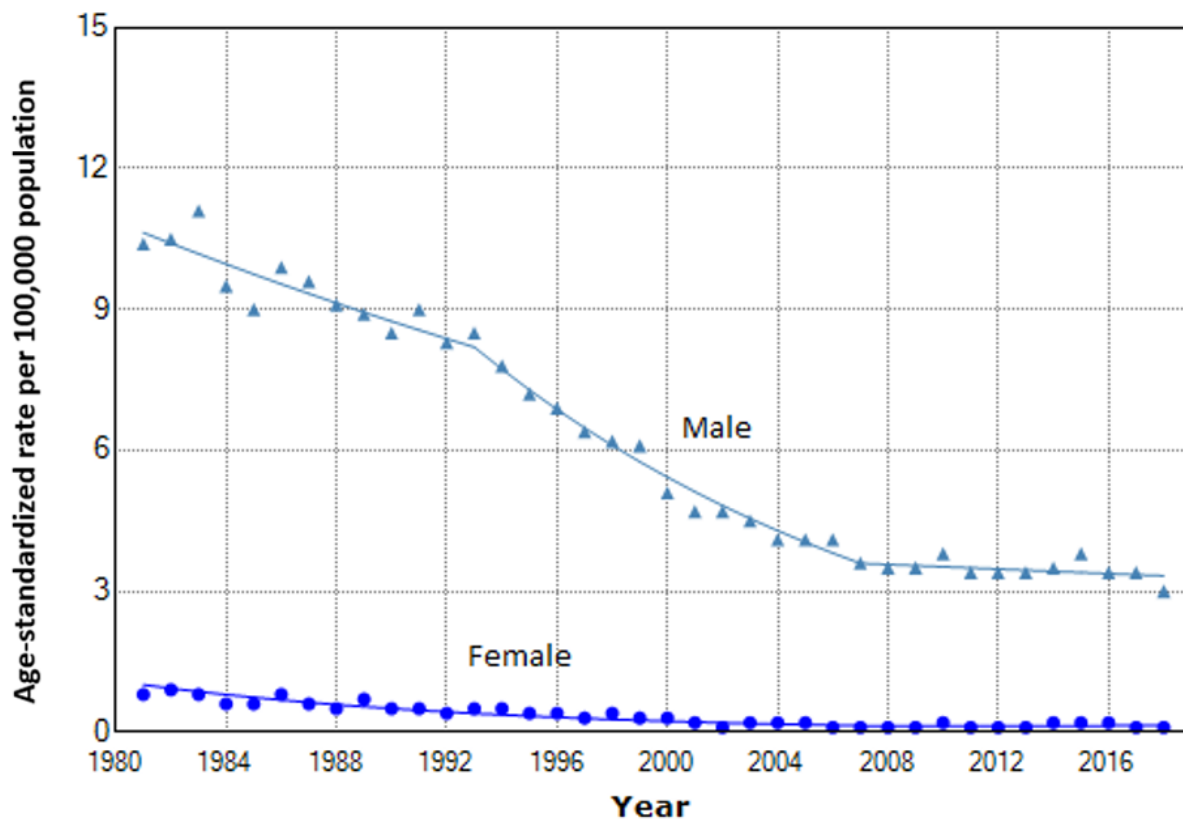


Figure S7. Age-standardized mortality rates of suicide by firearms or explosives by sex in Canada, 1981-2018.

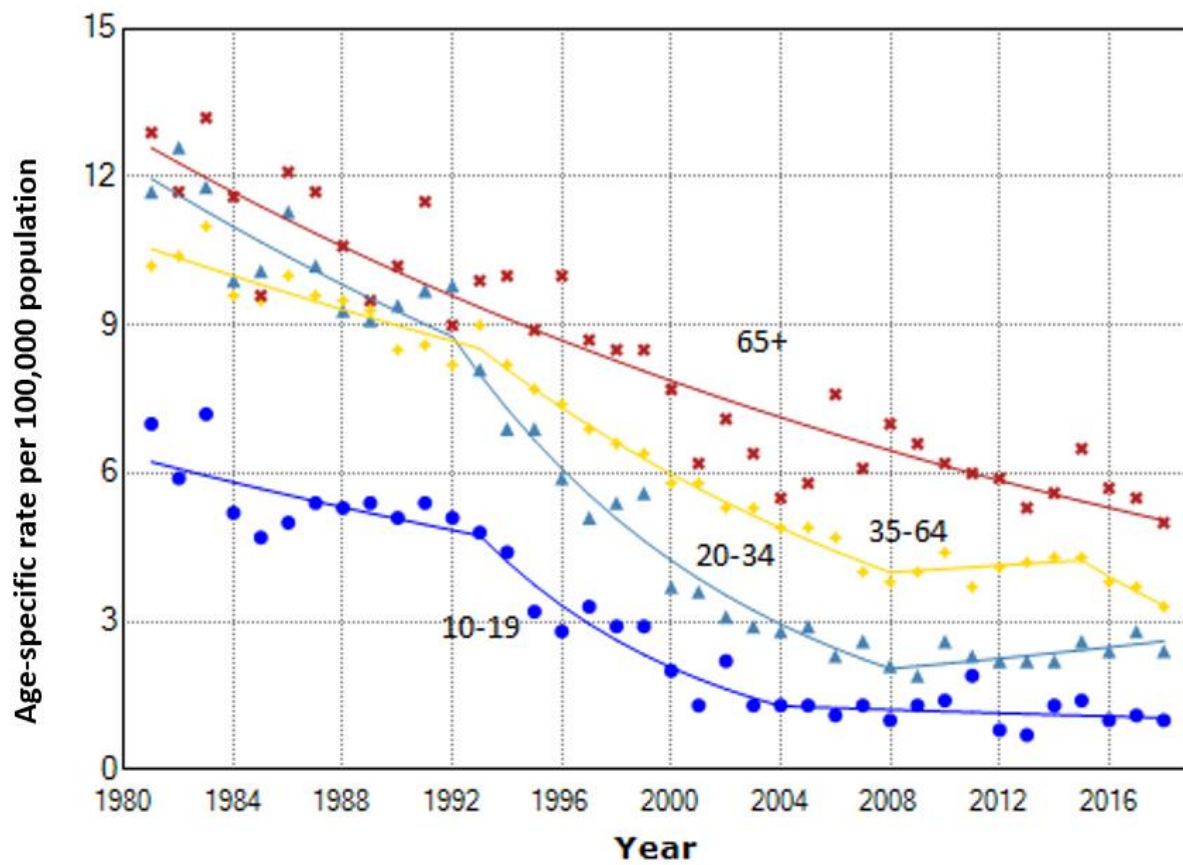


Figure S8. Age-specific mortality rates of suicide by firearms or explosives for males by age group in Canada, 1981-2018.
