Biographical details	Dr. Peter J Gill is a paediatric resident at The Hospital for Sick Children at the University of Toronto and an Honorary Fellow at the Centre for Evidence-Based Medicine (CEBM) at the University of Oxford. Peter holds an MD from the University of Alberta, and a DPhil in Primary Health Care and MSc in Evidence-Based Health Care at the University of Oxford, where he studied as a Rhodes Scholar. His research focused on developing evidence-based indicators to measure the quality of primary care provided for children. Peter has authored over 50 peer-reviewed publications, including articles in the <i>Lancet</i> , <i>BMJ</i> and <i>CMAJ</i> , and 6 book chapters on a range of topics, including medical education, health services research and clinical care. Peter is a member of the CIHR Institute Advisory Board on Health Promotion and Prevention, and is on the Organizing Committee for the Evidence Live conference in Oxford, jointly organized with the <i>BMJ</i> and CEBM. Peter has an active interest in medical education, co-founding the open-source paediatric medical education website PedsCases (www.pedscases.com) which has over 100 podcasts exceeding 1.6 million downloads. A social media enthusiast, Peter has an active Twitter account . His leadership contributions have been acknowledged with several awards including the CIHR IHSPR Rising Star Research Award and the Canadian Medical Association (CMA) Award for Young Leaders.
