Born in Russia, Dr. Enns' family emigrated to Mexico in 1924 and, a year later, settled in Canada. He was a man of interesting complexity: an ardent golfer, curler and a keen lover of poetry who was partial to recitations. "His pancakes became legendary and he mended his own socks." He is survived by his wife, Selma, sons, Kurt and Philip, and 3 grandchildren.
